



CATHERINE DEVEREUX BRANDSTRADER SCHOLARSHIP

The Catherine Devereux Brandstrader Scholarship was established by Mrs. Brandstrader's extended family through the Oak Park-River Forest Community Foundation to assist a female high school senior with college expenses of tuition and/or room and board. One female student will be awarded a \$1,000 scholarship each year.

The scholarship is specifically targeted to young women coming from large families that might find it difficult to manage multiple students attending college at the same time. Students must be attending Oak Park and River Forest, Fenwick, or Trinity High School.

The following specific criteria have been established:

1. The scholarship must go to support student tuition and/or room and board expenses at an accredited undergraduate institution;
2. The student must demonstrate financial need as determined by the scholarship application and the committee;
3. The student must be apart of a large family that could include multiple siblings attending college during the same time period.
4. The student must have maintained a B (3.0) average or better during high school.
